
NEW EMAIL ACCOUNT

 - Communicating with post-secondary institutions (PSIs)
 - Scholarship applications and communications
- This new account only for these purposes will ensure important information does not get lost in all of your other mail.
- Please use a mature, professional name when signing up as this will be your first impression with PSIs, scholarships, and myPass.
- Alternatively, if you are not going to post-secondary, rather getting a job, this account will also be useful for managing job applications and communications with potential and actual employers.

MYPASS

- Alberta Education Website
- Collects all of your educational information credits, marks, schools attended in Alberta
- Provides reports of this information to you and/or post-secondary institutions or employers – Detailed Academic Report, Transcript, High School Diploma
- Diploma Exam Marks
- There will be an email coming out with directions for you to sign up for this account. You need to do this IMMEDIATELY in order to be prepared to apply to post-secondary institutions.


